Managing Post-Pandemic Recovery. The normalisation of emergency socio-economic measures 2025

This article expounds on the findings of European-financed research concerning how different States grappled with the socioeconomic consequences of the pandemic and to what extent one can envisage non-marginal institutional and policy changes in the post-pandemic phase. The article investigates any connection between what the States are promising and the social impact of the COVID-19 crisis, appraising the general orientation of social policy reform in terms of institutional design and "philosophical" inspiration.

By the latter, we mean a social rights-based approach and an active social policy approach, also termed social investment. The Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF) is intended to bring about essential change. The approach is interdisciplinary, involving legal and sociological analysis, and relies on extensive and reliable

information to chart specific policy patterns valuable for decision-makers.

Therefore, rather than only examining how policies impact the socioeconomic situation, we also analyze how the socioeconomic situation influences the general political response. To this end, the article assesses a set of national jurisdictions against the backdrop of supranational legislation, such as the Recovery and Resilience Facility (RRF), , intended to bring about essential change.

The approach is interdisciplinary, involving legal and sociological analysis, and uses much reliable information to chart specific policy patterns valuable for decision-makers.

Città intelligenti e diritto all'abitare: transizioni nel social housing 2024

This article approaches housing deprivation as an example of poverty and social exclusion that could reveal some social policy trends in contemporary smart cities. The analysis focuses on the opportunities for social housing, meant as a set of activities aimed at providing adequate living conditions, first (but not exclusively) to those who do not have access to housing on the market. The findings highlight a "renewed" conception of social housing, going beyond the mere provision of homes, where public bodies could ensure everyone a "right to housing", enhancing – in terms of specific "urban housing services" – the innovative tools of smart cities. Exploring the content of the right to housing and its jurisdictional protection as a fundamental social right, an idea of "human smart city" as a place where rights are granted is suggested.

The paper examines the possible use of public class action for a jurisdictional protection of social rights. This introduces a different interpretation compared to the thesis which excludes that social rights can be judicially protected, because of their "political" or "material" structure. After a brief analysis of the "political" structure of social rights (their materiality), considering how this structure may constitute an obstacle to the 'classic' jurisdictional protection, the investigation aims to show how public class action enables to achieve an effective protection of social rights. In particular, the article suggests the use of public class action to guarantee the efficient organization and provision of social services, within the framework of the strengthening of welfare policies in Italy in the post-pandemic period.

L'azione amministrativistica di nullità. Per un raffronto con la nullità processualcivilistica 2024

The paper deals with the procedural regime of nullity of administrative acts (art. 31, co. 4 c.p.a.), compared with the regime of nullity established by the civil code. Particular attention is paid to the time limit for filing the administrative nullity action, which is apparently in contrast with the traditional archetype of nullity. The possibility to raise nullity as an objection during the hearing and the possibility for courts to raise nullity *ex officio*, in both cases without time limits, are then analysed, on a procedural and substantive level. The purpose is to detect possible ways of overcoming the dichotomy between the administrative nullity action and the civil one.

Verso un complessivo ripensamento dell'autodichia degli organi costituzionali 2024

Constitutional Court judgment n. 65/2024 marks an important step in the progressive reconceptualization of

self-declaration of constitutional bodies (domestic justice). The Court has definitively excluded domestic justice for public procurement disputes, recognizing the jurisdiction of the administrative judge; on the one hand clarifying Constitutional Court n. 262/2017 and on the other hand affirming the functional use of domestic justice to preserve the autonomy of constitutional bodies (the “functionalist thesis” stated by Constitutional Court n. 120/2014). After examining the judgment, the paper critically reviews the incomplete application of the functionalist thesis, to question the reasonableness of domestic justice with respect to disputes with employees. The focus is on the relationship between the autonomy of constitutional bodies and jurisdictional protection. Finally, some conclusions are drawn on the possible consequences of judgment n. 65/2024 for the sources of law system, the autonomy of constitutional bodies and access to justice.

Vitalizi, regolamenti parlamentari minori, autodichia 2024

The Guarantee Council – the “domestic judge” of the Senate – with decision n. 272/2023 has lastly cancelled rule n. 6/2018 of the Presidential Council of the Senate about the recalculation of former senators' annuities. The paper analyses this decision, reflecting on two main themes: the judicial review of internal regulation of each House of Parliament; the reasonableness of recalculation of annuities and the opportunity of a legislative regulation on this topic. The essay first criticises the domestic review of constitutionality on annuities rules, which have the rank of “minor” regulations and can be judged only by internal judges of Parliament. The specific provisions of decision n. 272/2023 are then examined, together with the related critical issues. Finally, some conclusions are drawn on the need to question the idea of “domestic justice”, since decision n. 272/ 2023 has sharpened the debate about political interference on domestic bodies of justice.

Constitutional Court judgment n. 157/2023 and n. 170/2023, concerning wiretapping of parliamentarians and seizure of parliamentarians' correspondence, define the extension of parliamentary immunities with respect to the right to judicial protection, supporting the functional thesis of parliamentary prerogatives. In this way, the Court marks an important step towards overcoming the privileges linked to political investiture (judgment n. 157/2023), without neglecting the actual needs for protection of prerogatives, to protect them from possible abuse (judgment n. 170/2023).

Starting from a specific view of the separation of powers and from an absolute idea of sovereignty, the review of the acts of constitutional bodies has traditionally been reserved to internal self-declaration ('autodichia') systems, without the intervention of common jurisdiction. This, however, collides with the constitutional order, where powers are balanced and interconnected and sovereignty is limited by the Constitution, based on the protection of the individual. The personalist values enshrined in the Constitution therefore require that constitutional bodies are to be subjected to the common system of justice. Considering the traditional conception of self-declaration of constitutional bodies as a form of privilege, the work proposes a different reconstruction of autodichia, coherent with the constitutional order, as an Alternative Dispute Resolution method that can be combined with common jurisdictional protection.

Institutional efficiency of public administration in the implementation of the National Recovery and Resilience Plan (NRRP) can be analyzed from the point of view of the advisory activity of the Council of State Section for Regulatory Acts. The paper therefore considers the relationship between implementation of NRRP and quality of regulation, and then focuses on recent opinions of the Advisory Section for Regulatory Acts on draft government regulations within the framework of NRRP, with specific reference to ecological transition, digitalization, social inclusion. The issue of regulatory drafting is finally considered. The aim is to reflect on the possible scenarios awaiting the public sector in the immediate future, at the same time questioning the implications of a renewed advisory function of the Council of State.

Constitutional Court judgment n. 171/2022, concerning the right for pharmacies and not for parapharmacies to carry out anti covid-19 tests, is based on the contrast between health and private economic initiative. Nevertheless, a deeper consideration of principles of proportionality and reasonableness as judgement parameters could have shown the lack of risks for health due to competition rules.

The essay analyzes the opinion n. 203/2021 of the First Section of the Council of State, concerning the extraordinary appeal to the President of the Sicilian Region as compared with the extraordinary appeal to the Head of State. The Council first points out which are the administrative acts that are to be appealed to the President of the Sicilian Region. Then, the Court focuses on the juridical nature of the extraordinary appeal to the Head of State, developed from an administrative remedy into a substantially jurisdictional one, following legislative changes and recent judgments. This provides an opportunity to question whether the extraordinary appeal to the President of the Sicilian Region should become a jurisdictional remedy as well, to grant the same legal protection.

Riflessioni sulla pianta organica nel quadro del servizio farmaceutico 2020

The pharmaceutical planning grid ("pianta organica") is a restriction of private economic initiative, because of the quota system of market operators and the geographical distribution of pharmacies. Traditionally, limiting market access in this sector is justified by the need to protect health, ensuring a proper distribution of dispensing pharmacies throughout the national territory. Nevertheless, the origin of this administrative instrument is linked to outdated reasons of objective protection of public health, inconsistent with Constitutional subjective protection of individual health. Moreover, the pharmaceutical legislation seems connected with protectionist interests. Within this framework, the paper questions whether it is necessary to overcome or revise the pharmaceutical planning grid. The removal of limits to the number and to the territorial distribution of pharmacies, indeed, might provide a wider access to pharmaceutical products, without actual

health risks, on the ground that the right to health could be interpreted as a driving force for competition rules.
